 Committee: Jim Beeson, Russ Ayers and David Swinney
 David Swinney updated Board. Committee agreed that a master
 installer that could cover their own systems was not a good idea.
 At some point in the future we may need to revisit issue of having
 a special inspector that does hold LSS or Evaluator. The G.S. that
 passed allows Evaluators to do inspections on LEH permitted
 systems.

Much discussion held about future inspection possibilities. Jim Beeson suggested that more education needed for installers.

Suggestions for future point of sale inspectors, various pathways must have either, Grade Level IV active installer certification minimum 2-5 years or W2 employee of certified installer or inspector for minimum 2-5 years, or active subsurface operator for minimum 2-5 years etc. Committee will continue to discuss potential increases in requirements and/or new types of certifications and report back to Board at the December meeting.
